MEMORANDUM FOR Balfour Beatty Community Residents

SUBJECT: Live Army Green Program

1. As your Garrison Commander, I would like to introduce you and your Family to the Live Army Green Program. This is a Department of Defense (DOD) mandated program in which military members, military Families and civilian employees are encouraged to be more conscious of the energy they use and how your actions can affect the environment.
2. As part of the Army Green Program, the Army has implemented an energy conservation program which is a congressionally supported policy which holds residents of Army privatized housing responsible for their utility usage. This program helps residents "Go Green" by becoming accountable for their gas and electric bills.
3. This Army program places the responsibility for utility consumption on each resident living in privatized housing. Those who consume energy conservatively may earn a rebate. Those who choose to use energy less conservatively or routinely waste energy may be billed for their "excess" consumption.
4. Balfour Beatty Communities will schedule and host Town Hall meetings for residents to explain the program and provide more detailed information on this Army energy initiative to include a timeline, mock billing, actual billing, rebates, metering, type of home and resident responsibilities.
5. I remind you that this is an Army initiative which our housing partner, Balfour Beatty Communities, will be adopting and implementing on our behalf and I encourage you to embrace the opportunities it can offer.
